Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan
Proposed Use of Funds for Anticipated Federal Awards

As an entitlement grantee of the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the City of Tallahassee is required to develop and submit an Annual Action Plan to HUD. The Annual Action Plan proposes uses of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding to implement strategies and programs to support affordable housing and community resilience. While the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) funds are not subject to federal regulations, they are leveraged when allocating federal funding. HUD also requires grantees to involve the public in the development of the Annual Action Plan and gain input on the potential uses for federal housing funds. *The award amounts below are conditional and may change based on final award notifications from HUD or the State of Florida.
